

California Area School District Foundation (CASDF) Scholarship Application Guidelines/Directions for 2026

All scholarships must be used during the 2026-2027 school year unless extenuating circumstances are approved by the Foundation. All referenced documents can be found on the Foundation website (calsdfoundation.org) or through the School District website under guidance.

Application Process for all Scholarships:

The student must provide the following completed documents to be considered as an applicant. In addition, you must meet any individual requirements of the particular scholarship for which you are applying.

- ◆ Resume' is **REQUIRED** (as email attachment)
- ◆ Scholarship application (as email attachment) – use provided PDF fillable form
- ◆ Personal interview questions (as email attachment) – use provided PDF fillable form
- ◆ Essay - only for those scholarships requesting (as email attachment) – use provided PDF form

High School Transcripts **will not** be required.

QPA/Grades will be obtained by the scholarship selection committee from the Guidance Office.

Letters of recommendation/references are only needed for those scholarships requesting.

Application Deadline: **March 13, 2026**

Failure to claim the scholarship in a timely manner and/or provide the necessary documentation will result in forfeiture of your scholarship.
